The minimum categories of race and ethnicity offered are very broad. Below are specific subcategories, called "specific or granular categories," that fall under each broad category.

Use these tables to help you select the correct minimum category of race and ethnicity when a patient self-reports a granular category that is not in our electronic medical records.

Minimum Category: Asian Refers to a person who has origins in the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent.

Minimum Category: Native American/Alaska Native Refers to a person who has origins in any of the original people groups of North or South America, including Central America, and who maintains tribal affiliations or community attachment.
