CDC Bridge Access Program

The CDC's Bridge Access Program offers COVID-19 vaccines at no cost for adults 18 years and older without health insurance and adults whose health insurance does not provide zero-cost coverage for COVID-19 vaccines. COVID-19 vaccines through this program are available at select local pharmacies, local boards of health, select community health programs.
