Head	Headache, syncope, trauma, fracture, mental status change, seizures, stroke, hematoma, shunt, hydrocephalus, HIV with headache	CT Head w/o IV	70450

	Metastatic melanoma (when MRI is not possible)	CT Head With & W/O IV	70470
Maxillofacial/Orbits	Trauma, fracture, Graves' disease	CT Maxillofacial W/O IV	70486

Soft Tissue Neck	Cellulitis, abscess, mass, swelling	CT Soft Tissue Neck W/IV	70491

Spine: Cervical, Thoracic, or Lumbar	Trauma, fracture	CT (Spine) W/O IV	72125
	Cord/cauda equina compression or infection & contraindication to MRI	CT (Spine) W/IV	72126
Extremity: Upper or Lower	Fracture, dislocation, foreign body (specify body part)	CT Upper/Lower EXT (part) W/O IV	73200/73700
	Cellulitis, abscess, mass (specify body part)	CT Upper/Lower EXT (part) W/IV	73201/73701
	Pleural effusion (F/U ONLY), pulmonary nodules < 2cm, emphysema, rib fx, aneurysm, pericardial effusion, pneumothorax	CT Chest W/O IV	71250
Chest	Interstitial lung disease, bronchiectasis, rheumatoid lung, COPD, asbestososis, pulmonary fibrosis, emphysema, sarcoid, lupus, rheumatoid arthritis, UIP, IPF NSIP, MAC/NTM – Indicate hi-res in comments	CT Chest W/IV	71250
	Infection, abscess, mets, tumor, hilar mass, post obstructive pneumonia, adenopathy, trauma, pain, pneumonia, pleural effusion, pulmonary Nodules > 2cm, SVC syndrome	CT Chest W/O IV	71260
Abdomen Only (Diaphragm to iliac crest only)	F/U known uncomplicated Pancreatitis, biliary obstruction, pain, mass, epigastric pain	CT Abdomen W/IV & Oral	74160
Liver Mass Protocol	Known or suspected hepatic mass, hemangioma, cholangiocarcinoma, hepatoma	CT Abdomen W & W/O IV	74170
	Indicate "Liver Mass Protocol" on order		
Pancreatic Protocol	Suspected Pancreatic mass, F/U known pancreatic lesion or cancer, Pseudocyst, Cancer, f/u complicated or necrotizing pancreatitis, f/u Whipple procedure.	CT Abdomen W/IV	74160
	Indicate "Pancreas Protocol" on order		
Renal Mass Protocol	History of or suspected Renal mass, cyst vs solid, Transitional cell	CT Abdomen W & W/O IV	74170
	Indicate "Renal Mass Protocol" on order

Abdomen & Pelvis (Diaphragm to symphysis pubis)	Renal stone, hematoma, hemorrhage, ruptured or leaking aneurysm, AAA Diverticulitis, appendicitis, bowel perforation, mets, abscess, generalized abdomen and pelvic pain, RLQ pain, LLQ pain, bowel obstruction, SBO, initial evaluation of possible pancreatitis of unknown severity, hernia	CT Abdomen & Pelvis W/O CT Abdomen & Pelvis W/ IV & Oral
Abdomen/ Pelvis (Kidney, Ureters, Bladder)	Hematuria, suspicion of urothelial malignancy Indicate "Urogram" on order	CT Abdomen & Pelvis W/O and W/IV
Abdomen/Pelvis (Virtual colonoscopy) (Small bowel exam)	Incomplete colonoscopy, screen for polyps or cancer of large intestines ** scripts required for patient to pick up a special prep called Tagitol and a Bowel cleansing prep from pharmacy.  Small bowel study, Crohns, colitis, IBS, assess for bowel wall inflammation, stricture, and fistula ** This is a timed study with oral prep called Neulumex. The patient will be given this oral prep at timed intervals within the department prior to scanning.	CT Colonography Diagnostic CT Colonography Screen
Pelvis (Iliac crest to Symphysis pubis anatomy only)	Fracture, dislocation Mass, abscess Bladder rupture, bladder injury	CT Pelvis W/O IV CT Pelvis W/IV and Oral CT Cystogram
Angio Chest	Pulmonary embolism, aneurysm, AAA, dissection, TEVAR, thoracic outlet syndrome	CT Angiogram Chest
Angio Abdomen	Renal artery stenosis	CT Angiogram Abdomen
Angio Abdomen/Pelvis	AAA, aneurysm, dissection, EVAR, mesenteric ischemia, GI bleed, renal donor, pre-op DIFCA	CT Angiogram Abdomen/Pelvis
Angio Head	Aneurysm, TIA, Stroke, Parenchymal hematoma	CT Angiogram Head
Venogram Head	Venous sinus thrombosis, pseudotumor	CT Head Venogram
Angio Neck	Aneurysm, stenosis, TIA, dissection, Trauma	CT Angiogram Neck
Angio Abdomen/Pelvis	Claudication, PVD, Ischemic lower limb, vascular injury with lower extremities	CT Angio Abdomen Aorta/Bilateral iliofem
Calcium Score	Atypical chest pain, CAD, myocardial degeneration	CT Heart W/O dye function
Pulmonary Vein Mapping	Pre-ablation pulmonary vein.	CT Heart W/ Dye function
Coronary Arteries	CAD, atypical chest pain, negative stress test, hyperlipidemia	CT Heart/3D/Morph
