Below are the expectations and required lectures in the first year. We support your advocacy for extra training where you deem necessary.

Your team leaders and the VMG Preceptors should be your contact people for questions and concerns.

Expectations for first year:

Orientation #1, #2.

Weekly meetings with VMG Preceptor for 3 months then as needed. To be arranged with VMG preceptor and practitioner.

Meetings/clinical reviews with Team leaders per schedule-booked during orientation

Monthly Clinical/Advisory Champion lunch and learns. These occur during lunch.

Primary care meetings in evenings every other month for clinical updates.

Executive Vice President Meeting to review financials. Scheduled by VMG Executive Assistant.

Billing Tutorial with VMG Billing Clinical Champion schedule in first 3 months.

Billing Workshop with Billing Specialist-scheduled in evening during first year.

Shadowing with specialists, medical director, dermatology-per request.

Completion of Primary Care Procedural Credentialing Verification with Team Leaders.

Completion of required trainings per Team leaders

Department meetings-All staff health center meeting and Practitioner meetings monthly during lunch. Mini team meetings for snapshot review monthly.
